Little about Commonwealth of Dominica

- An English speaking state on Eastern Caribbean
- Former British colony (1978), member of Commonwealth
- Population little over 73,000, Area 751 sq km
- Capital city: Roseau (14,000)
- Currency: Eastern Caribbean \$ (1\$=2.7 XCD fixed)
- GDP: \$1,02 Billion (\$13,600 per capita)
- Legal system: Parliamentary democracy

Dominica Citizenship by Investment program has many advantages, such as:

- A great option for second citizenship at reasonable cost
- No residency requirement
- No taxes unless you live in Dominica
- Easy travel within 12 Caribbean countries with Caricom Passport
- Visa free travel to over 80 countries including 6 months stay in UK

Program Highlights

- Investors must be over 21 years old
- Applicants must be of outstanding character, has clean source of funds and no criminal record
- Basic knowledge of the English required
- Processing time varies between 6 to 14 months
- All applicants must have a government approved representative
- All applicants must go through a personal interview
- There two options; single applicant and family applicant

CITIZENSHIP BY INVESTMENT



Investment Options

- **Package A: Single Applicant**

Investor is the sole applicant for economic citizenship no matter whether single or married. "Single" investor make non-refundable cash investment of US\$100,000

- **Package B: Family Application One (Applicant and Spouse)**

Investor-applicant pays US\$175,000, which qualifies the investor and the spouse for the economic citizenship

CITIZENSHIP BY INVESTMENT



- **Package C: Family Application Two (Applicant, Spouse, 2 Children below the age 18)**

Investor-applicant pays US\$200,000, which qualifies the investor, the spouse and two children under the age of 18

- **Package D: Family Application Three (Applicant, Spouse, 3 Children below the age 18)**

The investor-applicant pays US\$350,000, which qualifies the investor, the spouse and three children under the age of 18.

For each additional dependent 25 years old and under, an extra US\$ 50,000 per person should be added.

Other Applicable Fees

- Application fee - US\$1,000 per investor (Non-refundable)
- Processing fee - US\$200 per applicant (Non-refundable)
- Naturalization fee - US\$550 per applicant
- Stamp fee - US\$15 per applicant
- Passport fee – US\$100 per applicant
- Government due diligence fees – Variable (US\$5000 – US\$10,000)
- Authorized agent fees: \$35,000 and upwards
