UNITED KINGDOM INVESTMENT IMMIGRATION

The following criteria must be met:

- Must have at least **£1 million** of your own money held in a regulated bank in the UK

or

- Own **net personal assets exceeding £2 million**, and have money under your control in the UK amounting to no less than **£1 million** (which may include money **loaned** to you by a financial institution regulated by the UK Financial Services Authority);



UNITED KINGDOM INVESTMENT IMMIGRATION

Additional Criteria:

- Must be over 18 years of age;
- Intends to invest for 5 years at least £750,000 in eligible UK investments. The remaining £250,000 may be maintained in other forms of UK investments (e.g. bank deposit, UK property, etc.);
- Intend to make UK your main home by spending most of your time in the UK;
- Must maintain and accommodate yourself and your dependents without recourse to public funds.



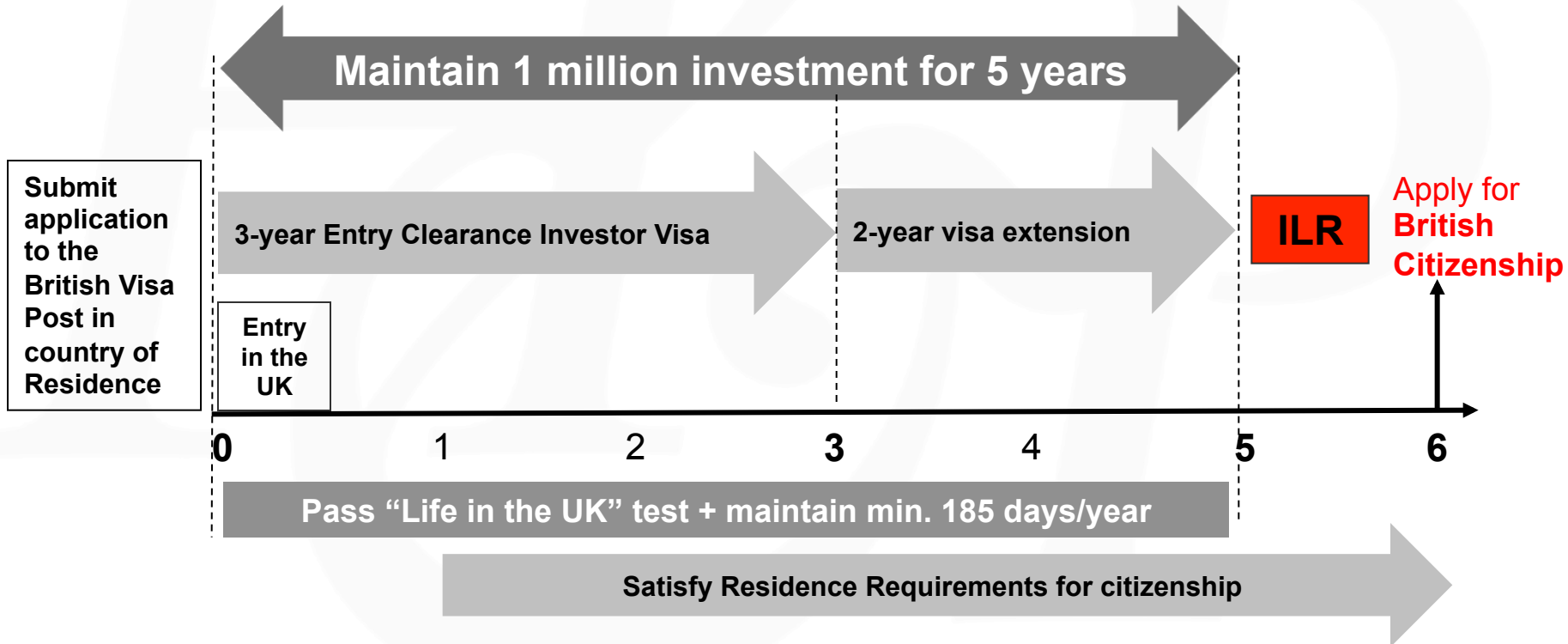
UNITED KINGDOM INVESTMENT IMMIGRATION

Advantage of the UK IIP:

- No English requirement to obtain visa;
- No Business Experience requirement;
- No medical evaluation, and government interview is often waived;
- Processing is very fast and applicant visas are generally approved very quickly – ranging from 1 week to 6 weeks

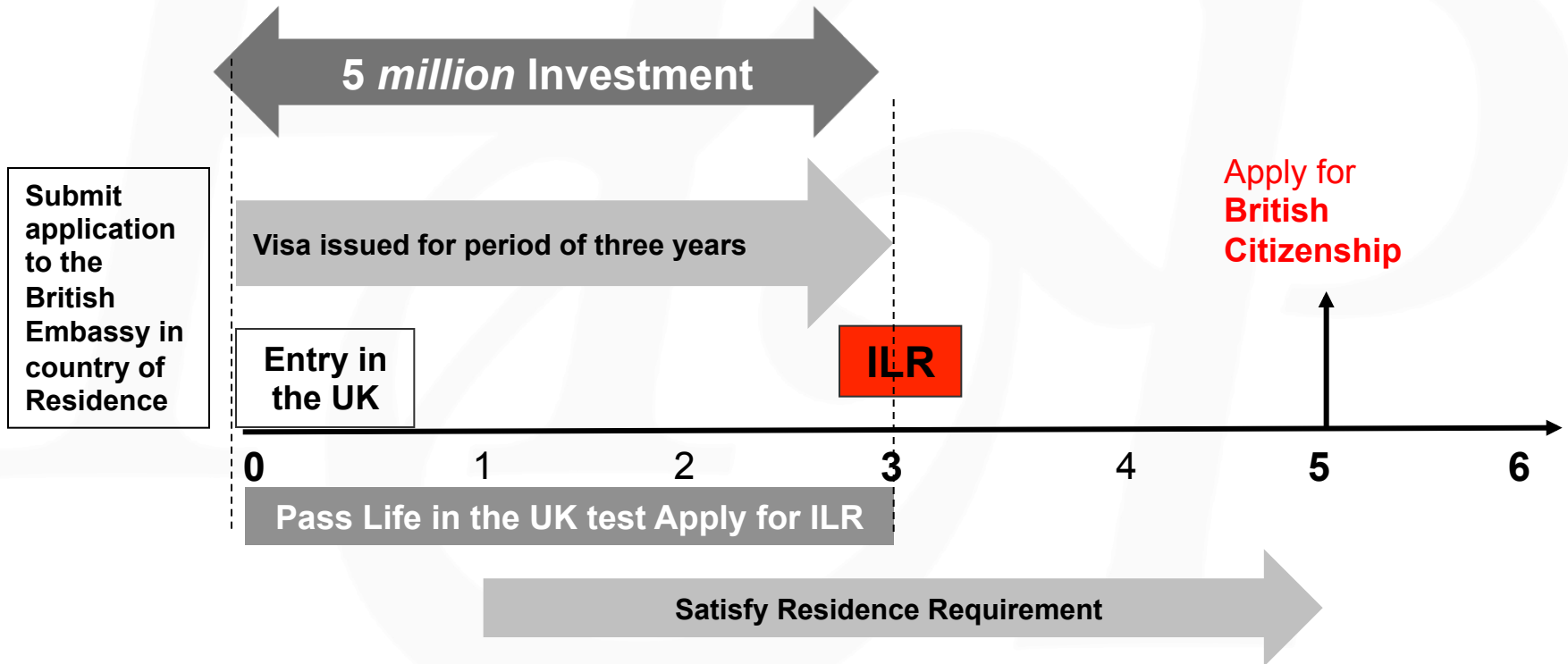

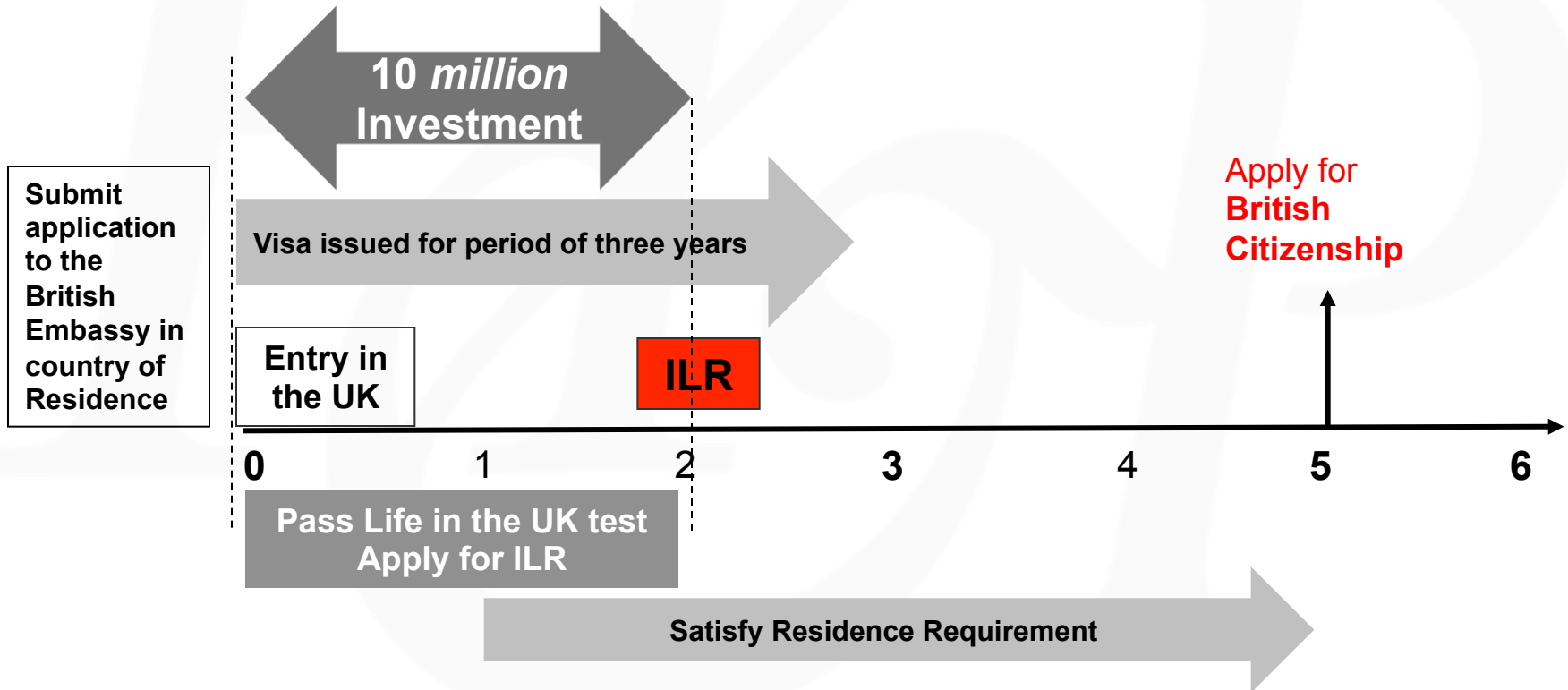

ILR

What are travelling restrictions for ILR holders?

- Once ILR has been granted, you may travel in and out of the UK any time. But you should not spend more than 2 years consecutively outside the UK.

British
citizenship

What about UK citizenship (i.e. British passport) ?

- Applicants may apply for British citizenship one year after being granted Indefinite Leave to Remain, providing they satisfy strict residential requirements below:
 - have been resident in the UK for 5 years, and
 - have been present in the UK 5 years before the date of citizenship application, and
 - have not spent more than 450 days outside the UK in 5 years, and
 - have not spent more than 90 days outside the UK in the 12 months preceding the application.
- Once UK citizenship has been granted, there is no restriction on time spent outside the UK.
- The UK allows to have more than one nationality.
